Tarou was originally found thave to be it more in February of 2007. I first saw him in March of that year at which the head a head the ad slightly left hemiparesis. MRI showed the huge tumor fixed to the one hird lateral for he right sphenoidal wing. I send him to the office of Professor Tetsuo Kanno who is a can bus Neurosurgeon of Fujita Health University and in April of 2007 he performed a tumo. Section. At the time of surgery, the tumor mass was totally removed from attached dura mater. The pathology specimen revealed a meningothelial meningioma. Post-operatively, he appeared to do well but continued to complain of headache and motor weakness of left upper extremity. This required hospitalization three weeks after surgery.

The following is his medication:

- 1) Phenytoin 200mg/day
- 2) Phenobarbital 100mg/day

I hope this information is helpful in your continuing follow –up of Tarou. I would certainly appreciate an occasional follow –up of this case.
